- 1. Exhibits will be received from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Friday August 16, 2024**
- 2. All entries must be in place 1/2 hour before judging starts.**
- 3. No entries can be removed before 7:00 p.m. on Saturday August 17, 2024**
4. A person shall not offer for exhibit any item not produced and / or prepared by him or herself in the past year.
5. An exhibitor shall make only one (1) entry in any class.
6. New classes shall be listed and judged provided there are three (3) or more entries.
7. Youth exhibits are for boys & girls up to age 16 as of January 1, 2024
8. Undesirable exhibits will not be excepted.
9. Placing shall be awarded on the basis of the quality of an exhibit and the decision of the judge is final.
10. All canned and preserved goods, including jams (except jelly) shall be sealed by processing
11. All perishable goods not called for by 7:15 p.m. will be disposed of or sold at auction. Proceeds will go towards helping to defray the cost of the fair.
- 12. RIBBONS WILL BE AWARDED IN ALL CLASSES.**
- 13. ONLY CLASSES WITH 3 OR MORE EXHIBITS WILL RECEIVE CASH AWARDS**

THE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS

1. Save time -make out enclosed entry blank ahead of time.
2. **The fair association is not responsible for loss or damage to exhibits or for injury to persons.**

SOME THINGS THE JUDGES LOOK FOR

Vegetables and Fruits

1. **Exact number** of specimens as called for in premium list.
2. **Uniformity**, all specimen alike in size, shape & color.
3. **Quality**, not to large, not to small, fine texture, etc.
4. **Free from** blemishes, cuts, bruises, insect injury or disease,
5. **Cleanliness**, product washed or wiped as one would to prepare it for market.
6. **ONIONS TO BE UNPEELED.**
7. **STEMS TO BE LEFT ON TOMATOES.**

Canned Goods

1. To be processed.
2. Products should be of the best quality, uniform in size and in good color.
3. The liquid should be clear, free from sediment, of proper consistency and the proper amount in the jar.
4. The containers should be uniform, clean, properly sealed and labeled.

BAKED GOODS

1. Properly wrapped and accompanied by the recipe
2. Attractive, good color, texture and flavor
